Dear Parents / Guardians,

1. We would like to thank you for partnering us throughout the course of this term.

Celebrating 85 Years of Fuhua Pride!

2. We are delighted to share that the school will be celebrating its **85th Anniversary** on **Saturday, 18 July**, centred on the theme **“Rooted in Gratitude, Serving with Purpose.”** To commemorate this significant milestone, a series of meaningful and exciting celebratory activities has been planned for our students and the school community. We kindly encourage parents/guardians to keep this date free and join us in celebrating this special occasion. More details regarding the celebrations will be shared at a later date.

Safety of Our Students

3. For safety and security reasons, parents/guardians who need to enter the school premises **are required to register with the security guard to obtain a visitor’s pass**. Upon obtaining the pass, please **proceed to the General Office for assistance from our staff**. Access to the classroom blocks is strictly restricted.

4. We would like to thank you for your continued support in ensuring our students' safety. There has been a significant improvement in traffic management around the school, reflecting your commitment to our students' well-being. Please use the public car park located opposite the school to park your vehicles during dismissal. We are confident that with your continued support, we can provide a safe environment for all road users.

5. Please take note of your child’s/ward’s after-school activities so that you are aware of his/her whereabouts after school hours. Students who remain in school for after-school activities are required to **stay within the school premises at all times** and are not allowed to leave the school to purchase food or visit nearby play areas. They should have their lunch at the school canteen and remain on the school premises until their after-school activities commence. We seek your support in reinforcing these guidelines with your child/ward.

Punctuality

6. We thank you for your continued support in promoting punctuality among our students. Whilst most students arrive on time, we have observed that some arrive after 7.30 am. Timely arrival is essential for your child/ward to start the day well and maximise his/her learning experience without disruption. Your partnership in ensuring your child’s/ward’s punctuality to school is greatly appreciated.

7. Advisory letters will be issued to parents/guardians of students **who continue to arrive late despite repeated reminders**.



Students with Medical Conditions

8. If your child/ward has medical conditions, such as asthma, please ensure that he/she brings along his/her personal medication to school. The medication must be clearly labelled with his/her name and class. Do check that the medication is not expired, and your child/ward is able to self-administer it.

9. Please notify the school immediately of any medical condition that your child/ward may have, so as to enable teachers to provide appropriate care and monitoring.

10. Absence from school must be covered by a medical certificate issued by a doctor if the student is unwell. You may write a letter to inform teachers of the absence of your child / ward. Do note that we will only accept up to **10 parents' letters per child per year** for absence from school.

Updating of Parents' / Guardians' Contact Details

10. You are required to update your contact details such as home address and contact numbers when there are changes. This allows the school to contact you immediately in the event of an emergency. You may make the changes via <https://pg.moe.edu.sg/forms/sdf>

11. The contact details of your child/ward should also be updated in his/her student organiser.

Emergency Preparedness

12. As part of our commitment to emergency preparedness, the school conducts regular safety briefings and emergency drills throughout the academic year. Our most recent fire drill, completed on 20 February, demonstrated our students' understanding of evacuation procedures and their ability to respond calmly and efficiently to emergency situations.

13. This year's temperature-taking exercise will be conducted in **Term 2, Week 2, on Wednesday, 1 April**. The exercise aims to familiarise students with temperature-taking procedures during pandemics. Please ensure that your child/ward brings a **working thermometer** to school on that day so that the exercise can be carried out in a timely manner.
