## WHAT ARE PARENTAL CONTROLS?

• Parental controls refer to a group of settings that put you in control of what your child can see and do on a device or online.

• Such controls can allow you to supervise and monitor your child's online activities and protect them from inappropriate content, online sexual grooming, cyberbullying and other online risks.

• Parental control settings can be used to monitor and limit screen time as agreed with your child.

It is important to have conversations with your child, to let them know:



1. You care for them and want them to be safe online.



2. Why there is a need to put these parental controls in place.



3. How parental controls keep them safe.

# SAFETY FEATURES TO PROTECT YOUR CHILD ONLINE

#### Set Up Internet & Broadband Controls

- Telecommunication operators offer **paid add-ons** for better control:
  - Singtel Surf School Includes Qustodio parental control software.
  - StarHub JuniorProtect Blocks unsafe websites and limits usage.
  - M1 Cyber Guardian Customizes content filters and screen time limits.

### Configure Device Safety Settings

- Use free parental controls like Google Family Link (Android) and Apple Screen Time (iOS) to set screen time limits, block inappropriate content, and monitor app usage.
- Restrict app downloads to allow only age-appropriate apps and games.
- Disable location services to prevent your child from unintentionally sharing their whereabouts.

#### Monitor & Guide Online Activity

- Regularly review privacy settings on social media and gaming platforms.
- Use in-app safety features to manage who your child interacts with online.
- Encourage open conversations about online safety to build trust and responsible habits.
