Dear Parents / Guardians,

1. Welcome back to another exciting term. We hope that the holidays have provided you with opportunities to bond with your children / wards.

Safety of Our Students

2. We would like to thank you for your ongoing support in ensuring our students' safety. We have noticed significant improvement in traffic management around the school particularly during dismissal. We are confident that with your continued support, we can provide a safe environment for all road users.

3. We urge you to take note of the after-school activities for your child/ward so that you are aware of your child's/ward's whereabouts after school hours. Students participating in after-school activities **must remain** within school premises for lunch at the canteen. They are not allowed to leave the school to purchase food or visit nearby play areas. We would appreciate if you could reinforce these guidelines with your child/ward.

4. Kindly be reminded of the dismissal times and designated gates for your children / wards and share this information with other family members / caregivers responsible for picking up your child after school.

Punctuality and Attendance

5. We would like to emphasise the importance of regular attendance and punctuality for your child's / ward's learning. Regular attendance and timely arrival are fundamental to your child's / ward's educational success. When students maintain consistent attendance and arrive on time, they build a strong foundation for learning without gaps in knowledge. Furthermore, continuous class participation fosters a better understanding of lessons and strengthens relationships with teachers and peers.

6. To ensure optimal learning, students should arrive by 7.30 am to prepare for flag-raising. Late arrivals disrupt both your child's / ward's learning and that of their classmates.

7. Absence from school must be covered by a medical certificate issued by a doctor if the student is unwell. You may write a letter to inform teachers of the absence of your child / ward. Please note that **we will only accept up to 5 parents' letters per child per semester** to excuse absences from school.

Instilling Responsibility in Our Students

8. To cultivate a reading culture among our students, we have designated reading time from 7.15 am to 7.30 am on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays before Assembly. During this period, students may read books in English or their Mother Tongue language. While books are available in the Hall, students may also bring appropriate reading materials from home.

9. Good habits and self-discipline are essential for our students' development. As a school, we teach our students to be responsible for their own belongings, through actions such as packing their own school bag daily. We would therefore urge you to refrain from bringing your child's / ward's stationery or schoolwork, should he / she forget to bring it to school. We will not deliver these items to the students should they be brought to the school, as this approach helps promote responsibility and accountability.

10. Students who have lost their wallets / ezlink cards / spectacles, may check the Lost and Found cabinet in front of the General Office. They may approach the staff at the General Office to retrieve their items from the cabinet. Students who have lost their lunch boxes or water bottles may check at the Lost and Found corner adjacent to canteen stall 1.

11. In line with our school rules of 'Love Others,' we are committed to nurturing a culture where respect and kindness are integral to daily interactions. Such positive interactions contribute to building a supportive and inclusive school environment. We encourage parents and guardians to reinforce these values at home, fostering a consistent message that promotes a caring and respectful community.

12. As ambassadors of our school, students are expected to maintain exemplary discipline in public places and on public transport. We urge you to reinforce proper and safe behaviour with your child/ward, helping him/her develop into a civic-conscious citizen.
